For seven summers, Larry "Rock" Brenner' Brenner stood in the thirdbase coach's box and watched more of his players pass by than any other coach in the summer recreational league. He guided Mount Wolf to every Central League and York County title since 1987.

Brenner died of a heart attack in 1994 at age 56. His family and friends held a memorial service at the field, with Brenner's casket resting where he stood in life. Mount Wolf's players sat in the home dugout and the field was dressed for a game, including fresh chalk along the baselines.

"It's ironic that on a day when professional players and owners are being consumed by another strike, that we pause to honor a player and manager who devoted countless hours to baseball simply because he loved the game," family friend Bill Zimmerman said.

In 2010, Mayor Josh presented Pasty Brenner and John Brenner with a Borough anniversary Rock Brenner banner that will be flown at the Rock Brenner Memorial Field. Rock contributed much to the community and to local baseball from 1937 to 1994.
