

The Beacon Light



Located at the intersection of the Susquehanna Trail and Copenhaffer Road in Zion View, the light served as a guide for planes without radar. It was constructed in mid 1930s, decommissioned in the early 1960s and the beacon was removed in 1970. The tower was torn down in 1975. After being refurbished by John Shue in 2004 the light that sat atop the tower is now in the York County Agricultural and Industrial Museum after years of service at the York Airport.
