

Mt Wolf, Pa., Oct 10<sup>th</sup>, 1910.

Pursuant to notice previously given to all the members-elect, the Town Council of the Borough of Mt Wolf met for organization at 7 o'clock P.M., in the public school house of Mt Wolf.

The Chief Burgess-elect and the members-elect of Town Council present were: Geo A. Wolf Burgess, J. S. Kunkel, J. P. Wogan, J. J. Rodes, W. D. Linbaugh, C. T. Kinports, E. B. Diehl and Levi Melhorn.

The oath of office was then administered to the Chief Burgess and the members of the Town Council, by J. H. Buser, Esq.

On motion of Mr J. S. Kunkel seconded by Mr J. P. Wogan, J. J. Rodes was chosen Secretary pro tempore. Motion carried.

The Chief Burgess announced that nominations were in order for a President of the Town Council, whereupon J. S. Kunkel was nominated and unananimously elected thus the Chief Burgess declared Mr J. S. Kunkel duly elected, and resigned his chair to him.

On motion of Mr J. P. Wogan, seconded by Mr C. T. Kinports, it was resolved to proceed to the election of a Secretary of the Town Council, a Borough Treasurer, and a Borough attorney for one year. Motion Carried.

On motion of Mr J. P. Wogan, seconded by Mr E. B. Diehl, the salary of the secretary of the Town Council be fixed at ten dollars (\$10) per year. Motion Carried.

On motion of Mr. I. P. Wogan, seconded by C. T. Kimperts, the salary of the Borough Treasurer was fixed at ten dollars (\$10) per yr. he being required to give bond, with security to be approved by Council, in the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600).

On motion of I. P. Wogan, seconded by J. J. Roder, the salary of the Borough Attorney was fixed at \$25.00 per yr. for all ordinary services, but not to include services in Court proceedings, nor in the issuing of bonds. Carried.

The following nominations were made for Secretary of the Town Council L. Allen Melhorn was nominated and having received the majority of votes was declared duly elected by the President after which he assumed the duties of his office.

The following nominations were made for Treasurer Daniel Diehl was nominated and having received the majority of votes was declared duly elected by the President.

The following nominations were made for Borough Attorney G. W. Kain was nominated, having received the majority of votes was declared duly elected by the President.

On motion of L. B. Melhorn, seconded by C. T. Kimperts, it was resolved that a committee of three be appointed to procure a Borough seal, a minute book, ordinance book, order book, and such other supplies as may be necessary, the seal to bear the inscription, "Seal of the Borough of Mount Wolf, York Co., Pa. Incorporated August 23<sup>rd</sup> 1791," together with the Coat of arms of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The President appointed the following as such Committee  
J. P. Wogan, G. A. Wolf and C. T. Kimpforts.

On motion of J. P. Wogan, seconded by Leri Melhorn  
it was resolved that a committee of three be appointed  
to draw up and submit Rules of Order for the govern-  
ment of Council. Motion Carried.

The President appointed the following as such Committee  
J. J. Rodes, Leri Melhorn and W. D. Linbaugh.

On motion of C. T. Kimpforts, seconded by J. J. Rodes  
it was resolved that the regular meetings of Council  
be held on the first (yet) Tuesday of each month, at 7  
o'clock P. M. at the Public School house. Motion Carried.

On motion of J. J. Rodes, seconded by Leri Melhorn, it was  
resolved that the Chief Burgess, President of Council and  
the Borough attorney, be authorized, together with the Secy,  
to take all necessary steps execute all necessary papers  
and bring all necessary proceedings in the proper Courts  
Courts, for the speedy adjustment of the rights and  
liabilities between the Borough of Mount Wolf and the  
township of East Manchester. Motion passed unanomously.

On motion of J. P. Wogan, duly second, it was resolved that  
the certificates of election and the oaths of office of the  
Borough officers be filed. Motion carried.

On motion of Leri Melhorn, duly seconded Council  
adjourn. Motion Carried.
