Bonge Frederick, Son of Henry B. & Sarah A Bonge*, 87th PA Sep 1861 - Oct 1864,

At the Wilderness May 6, 1864, was ruptured when struck in the abdomen with the butt of a gun.

Bonge Daniel, Son of Henry B. & Sarah A Bonge*, 87th PA Sep 1861 - Jan 1865,

Captured at Carter's Woods and returned to regiment October 5, 1863

Bongey Frederick Daniel, Son of Daniel B. & Elizabeth Bongey, 12th PA Dec 1862 - Feb 1863,

Wounded at Fredericksburg when a ball entered his nose and exited through his neck returned to 45th PA Feb 1864 - June 1865

Bongey Daniel, Son of Daniel B. & Elizabeth Bongey, 87th PA US Navy Aug 1861 - May 1864

Deserted to the Navy, serving aboard the U.S.S. Richmond desertion charge lifted in 1895 and given a May 1864 discharge date, changed spelling of last name to "Bonge".

Kunkle Jacob, Son of Jacob & Mary Kunkle, 207th PA Sept 1864 - May 1865

Rodes Zebulon Pike, Son of Daniel & Susanna Rodes, 100th PA Nov 1862 - July 1863

Smith Jacob, Son of Jonas & Nancy Ann Smith, 103rd PA March 1865 - June 1865
