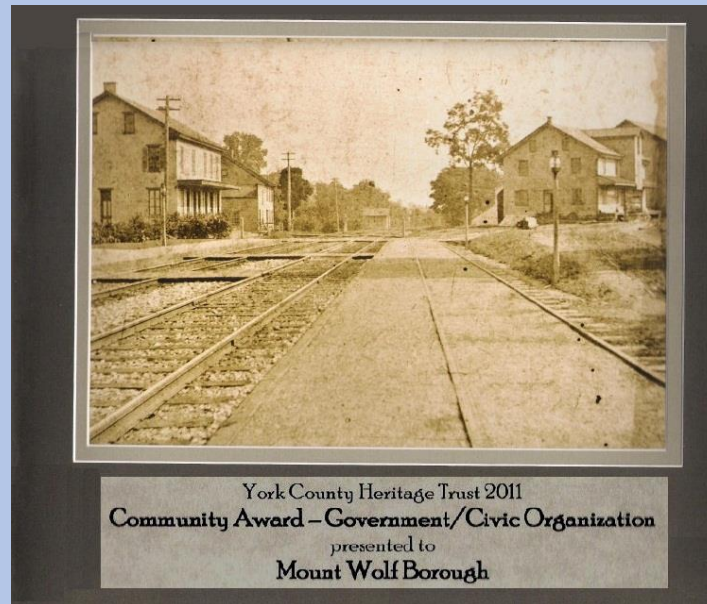


York County Heritage Trust Community Award
